The Heidegger Circle invites submissions of papers and panel proposals on any aspect of Heidegger's thought.

PAPERS

Papers should not exceed 4,000 words (excluding 150-word abstract, footnotes, and references), with a reading time of 30 minutes. Papers should be prepared for blind review and submitted with a separate cover sheet that includes name, e-mail, and affiliation (if applicable). If accepted, papers will be published in the *Proceedings*, which will be available both online and in print at the meeting. Authors who submit papers to the Heidegger Circle meeting are welcome to revise and expand their essays and submit them to *Gatherings: The Heidegger Circle Annual*.

PANELS

Panels include three brief presentations (approximately ten minutes each) on the panel topic, allowing significant time for discussion. Panel proposals should include (a) the panel title and a 150-word abstract of the panel topic, and (b) the titles and a 150-word gloss for each panelist's contribution. These proposals should be prepared for blind review with a separate cover sheet including names, e-mails, and affiliations of the panelists (if applicable).

SUBMISSIONS

Submissions should be single-spaced, 12-point font size, Times New Roman or Garamond, 1" margins, footnotes rather than endnotes, in .doc or .docx version (no PDFs, please).
